Subject: New Governmental Restrictions on Common Area Use

Pursuant to Virginia Governor Northam's Executive Order Number 63, issued on May 26, 2020 the following restriction is established.

REQUIREMENT TO WEAR FACE COVERING WHILE INSIDE BUILDINGS

Page 2, Section A. of the order states; All patrons in the Commonwealth aged ten and over shall when entering, exiting, travelling through, and spending time inside the settings listed below cover their mouth and nose with a face covering, as described and recommended by the CDC.

Page 2, Section A. Number 6 of the order states; Any other indoor place shared by groups of people who are in close proximity to each other. This restriction does not apply to persons while inside their residence or the personal residence of another.

This order shall be effective 12:00 a.m. Friday, May 29, 2020, and shall remain in full force and effect until amended or rescinded by further executive order.

Violations of the Order are a Class 1 misdemeanor. The State Health Commissioner may also seek injunctive relief in Circuit Court to prevent any acts that violate the Order.

Some examples of UVOA specific situations would be when you are traversing through the common areas, using the arts and crafts room, watching movies in the meeting room, attending committee meetings in person, or simply having a conversation in the common areas such as the lobby.

Please notify any caregivers, employees, contractors, friends, and family that may be coming to see you of the new requirement.
